Background: The protein encoded by this gene belongs to the small GTPase superfamily, Rab family. The protein is membrane-bound and may be involved in protein transport and small GTPase mediated signal transduction. Mutations in this gene are associated with Griscelli syndrome type 2. Alternative splicing occurs at this locus and four transcript variants encoding the

same protein have been identified.

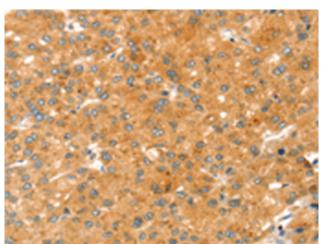

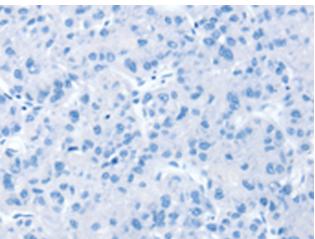

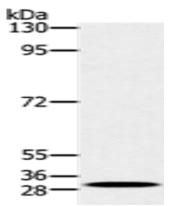

Immunohistochemistry analysis of paraffin embedded Human liver cancer tissue using 217731(RAB27A Antibody) at a dilution of 1/30(Cytoplasm).



In comparision with the IHC on the left, the same paraffin-embedded Human liver cancer tissue is first treated with the fusion protein and then with 217731(Anti-RAB27A Antibody) at dilution 1/30.
