Description: Anti-PIK3CA(D549N) Mouse Monoclonal Antibody

Background: Phosphatidylyl 3-kinases (PI3K) are a family of lipid kinases involved in many cellular processes, including cell growth, proliferation, differentiation, motility, and survival. It is composed of an 85 kDa regulatory subunit and a 110 kDa catalytic subunit. Mutants of PIK3CA has been found in the pathogenesis of several cancers, including colon cancer, gliomas, gastric cancer, breast cancer, endometrial cancer, and lung cancer.

Immunogen: A synthetic peptide from the internal region of PIK3CA which includes the mutation of D549N, human origin.



Constituents: PBS (without Mg²⁺ and Ca²⁺), pH7.4, 150 mM NaCl, 50% glycerol

Species Reactivity: Recognizes D549N mutant, but not wild-type PIK3CA of vertebrates

Storage Conditions: Store at -20°C. Avoid freeze / thaw cycles.

Western blot:




Western blot analysis of recombinant PIK3CA (D549N) and wild type proteins.

Purified His-tagged PIK3CA (D549N) protein (lane 2) and corresponding wild type protein (lane 1) were blotted with anti-PIK3CA (D549N) monoclonal antibody (Cat. #26215).

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Immunofluorescence:



Immunofluorescence of cells expressing PIK3CA proteins with anti-PIK3CA (D549N) antibody.

HEK293T cells were transfected with pCDNA3-GFP-PIK3CA (WT) plasmid (left column) or pCDNA3-GFP-PIK3CA (D549N) plasmid (right column), then fixed and stained with anti-PIK3CA (D549N) monoclonal antibody (Cat. # 26215).

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
